The Central District Board is pleased to announce “Central District Day 2012.” All KEA members are invited and encouraged to attend this wonderful event for a chance to be truly involved in their association.

District Day is a two part event. Early in the day members will have the opportunity to participate in a district business meeting. At this meeting the district budget will be reviewed, KEA President Scholarships will be awarded, constitutional amendments will be proposed, and new district officers will be elected by the delegates chosen to represent each of the twenty-six school districts in Central District.

In the afternoon, Central District hosts a unique professional development opportunity. This year’s professional development is centered on the theme of *Teacher Quality*.

The professional development session will begin with a showing of *The Mitchell 20*, a documentary about twenty elementary school teachers, from the same school, who pursue their National Board Certification together to help change the course of their “failing” school.

Following the film will be a discussion on teacher effectiveness in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Panelists will explore with participants the future of teacher evaluations in the state, as well as related teacher quality issues.

Participants will be provided with information about various KEA sponsored events that support National Board Candidates.

All District Day participants will leave with three hours of quality professional development.
